Data Challenges

- ☐ Missing and incomplete data available
- ☐ Transition from SCT to Ellucian Banner 2016-2017
- □ Lack of contextualization
- □ Communication issues

Programs and Interventions

- ☐ Statutory changes requiring implementation
- Not evaluating initiatives □ 2014-2015 declining enrollment
- ☐ University College not effectively serving students

Leadership Transition and Organizational Structure

- □ 2015-2017 New Executive Leadership
- ☐ 2018 New Assessment & Student Learning Leadership
- No working groups to evaluate and assess initiatives

Student Attrition & Graduation Rates

- ☐ Heavy reliance on Anecdotal Evidence
- ☐ Pressure to improve Persistence & Completion, but no coherent way to pursue these goals

- ☐ Academic Resource Center and Assessment work collaboratively with faculty to evaluate, implement, and improve


Student Attrition & Graduation Rates

Remedial Course Pass Rates 2016-2018








from fall to fall Persistence Students who nersisted from fall to fall Completion Students who graduated from fall to fall
