Follow these steps to apply for OPT STEM Extension

Please keep in mind that filing of the I-765 can take up to 3 months once it reaches the USCIS Service Center to be approved.

1. Discuss your eligibility for the STEM extension with your international advisor.

2. You must have the items below to apply:

3. ____ Completed I-765 Application - Marked (c)(3)(B)-<u>Must have employer's E-verify name</u> and company identification number!

- 4. Photocopy of all previous I-20s
- 5. Photocopy of all previous EADs
- 6. Copy of your degree (transcripts or copies of diplomas that indicate the level of the degree and the field of study would be acceptable.)
- 7. Check or money order for the filing fee (\$380).
- 8. Two identical immigration-style photos
- 9.____ Photocopy of I-94 (Both sides).
- 10.____ Photocopy of Passport ID pages

11. The International advisor will prepare an I-20 requesting STEM extension.

12. Student must sign the I-20!

If you are approved for the OPT STEM Extension, you will be required to report your current address and employer every 6 months from the date your extension begins as noted on the EAD card. This will be two separate reporting dates during your STEM extension.
