

Minutes from Faculty Senate Meeting

Friday, February 9, 2024, at 11:00 am in SAB 202

Call meeting to order:

• Discuss the OPSU Faculty Forum Q& A Meetings.

Dr. Bensch shared that most faculty from his perspective do not want another question-and-answer forum with Dr. Dinger (as was discussed in the previous Faculty Senate meeting). Dr. Dinger has held multiple meetings as well as Brown Bag lunch meetings in the past few weeks to share her views and answer questions. All faculty and staff have had opportunity to attend one or more of these meetings to ask questions and hear Dr. Dinger and Dr. Billiot's point of view.

- Previously tabled "Vote of No Confidence" referendum. Lengthy discussion on the referendum. A motion was made by Hue Helms to remove from the table the "Vote of No Confidence" motion, Vicki Pasque seconded. A roll call vote was taken (see below). Motion passed and the "Vote of No Confidence" will be put before the full-time faculty.
