

## University-Wide (Mandatory) Fees Per Credit Hour (pch)

**Activity Fee (pch) \$14.00 P** Applies to all students. Provides support to student activities and life on campus, providing learning opportunities for students outside of the classroom in support of the university experience.

**Auxiliary Fee (pch) \$5.50 P** Applies to all students. In addition to funds being used to support campus-wide maintenance of facilities, upgrades to utility, network and voltage systems and enhancements to technology infrastructure and equipment, funds will also be directed to units that support the day-to-day functioning of the campus.

**Cultural and Recreation Fee (pch) \$1.00 P** Applies to all students. Provides support to such programs, services and organizations as intramural athletics, sports clubs, and minority student organizations.

**Energy Fee (pch) \$16.00 P** Applies to all students. The fee supports the utility costs of operating campus buildings and equipment.

**Facility Fee (pch) \$15.50 P** Applies to all students. The fee supports the continued upkeep of campus buildings and infrastructure.

**Library Fee (pch) \$4.00 P** Applies to all students. Defrays the cost of equipment, software, and other aspects related to operating the on-line computerized library service. These fees also provide student access to heavily used electronic journals and on-demand information services despite escalating costs and the termination of services by outside library agencies.

**Security Fee (pch) \$11.00 P** Applies to all students. Revenue from this fee allows for additional FTE for campus security officers in order to keep students, staff and faculty safe and also safeguard buildings and equipment as well as security cameras.

**Student Assessment Fee (pch) \$3.00 P** Applies to all students. Provides assessment of student learning to improve the education experience and maintain compliance with accreditation criteria set forth by the Higher Learning Commission.

**Student Government Fee (pch) \$1.00 P** Applies to all students. Provides support to program, service, and organization of SGA (Student Government Association).

**Student Union Fees (pch) \$18.00 P** Applies to all students. The fee supports the continued upkeep of the Student Union.

**Technology Fee (pch) \$16.00 P** Applies to all students. Provides for the maintenance of existing facilities and computer equipment, and the expansion and development of central facilities, hardware, software, and multimedia capabilities, as well as covering increasing costs in multiple areas, including network and system infrastructure, hardware and software costs and communications. Another priority of revenue from this fee will be to upgrade system security in an effort to prohibit University computer networks from being susceptible to hackers.

**Campus Notification Fee (pch) \$1.00 P** Applies to all students. Provides for the implementation of additional campus safety measures that include the Rave communication system to notify students and staff should there be an emergency situation.

**Campus I.D. Fee (pch) \$3.35 P** Applies to all students, to cover costs of campus student ID systems, which connects to library and database services, dining services, and door access.

**Counseling Fee (pch) \$3.50 P** Applies to all students. Funds student assistance if needing help with study skills, coping with the stress of balancing college, work, and a personal life, personal counseling, or who are in a crisis situation. Request help by contacting the Counseling Center.

**Academic Equipment Fee (pch) \$3.00 P** Applies to all students. Funds renovation, maintenance, operations and construction of classroom and academic facilities necessary to support contemporary instruction and the demands of growing enrollment.

## University-Wide (Mandatory) Fees Per Semester (ps)

**Publications Fee (ps) \$20.00 P** Applies to all students, excluding the summer term, to cover costs associated with campus publications.

**Health Services Fee (ps) \$25.00 P** Applies to all students, excluding the summer term. Provides for comprehensive nursing services. This fee offsets costs and allows University Health Services to provide services at a significantly discounted rate that keeps students' copay and out-of-pocket costs low.

**Communications Fee (ps) \$10.00 P** Applies to all students, to cover costs associated with campus communications.

**Academic Records Fee (ps) \$2.00 P** Applies to all students. Provides for the maintenance of the academic record system and issuance of official transcripts.

## College Course Based Fees (Academic Service Fees)

Course Fees include:

- Provides for the maintenance of specialized technology needs of each of the various colleges.
- Used to fund enhancements to instruction within each college, including equipment, technology, facilities, and salaries to support instruction.
- OPSU continues to develop and implement programs to ensure student success. Examples include our tutoring services, resource centers, corequisite instruction models, etc. This fee will help support these and other services.
- Fees range from \$5 to \$30 per credit hour, or a flat fee of up to \$75 per course.

## College of Business and Technology Course Fees

SCHOOL OF BUS & TECH FEE

### Academic Service Fees (Fees may be assessed per semester (ps), per credit hour (pch), or per course (pc))

Athletic Fee (ps) \$30.00 **P** Applies to all students, excluding those classified as fully online. Students have access to any sporting event, free of charge at the gate. This fee also provides coverage for accident insurance. For information on accident insurance, visit [FAQ Accident Insurance](#).

Laundry Fee (ps) \$25.00 **P** Applies to students in residential housing, to cover costs associated with equipment maintenance and use.

Housing Fee (ps) \$53.00 **P** Applies to students in residential housing, to cover costs associated with domestic wastewater system.

Student Safety, Security, and Life Fee (pch) \$20.00 **P** Applies to all students, excluding those classified as a Senior (having completed 90 hours or above.) At the beginning of each subsequent semester, the fee will cease to be charged to students once they've reached Senior status. This fee helps offset the cost of upkeep for parking, campus police services, and campus safety programming.

International Students Maintenance Fee (ps) \$15.00 **P** Applies to International Students only.

Parking Decal Fee \$10.00/\$1.00 **P** \$10.00--Initial decal; \$1.00--Each additional decal. Applies to students parking on campus, to cover costs of parking decals.

Replacement I.D. \$10.00 **P** Applies to students needing replacement ID.

Classroom Improvement Fee (pc) \$7.00 **P** Applies to students in traditional courses, excluding students in online courses, to cover costs of modernizing classroom learning environments (i.e. modern classroom furniture, etc.)

Corequisite Support Fee (pc) \$100.00 **P** Applies to students in corequisite course, to cover costs to remediate students not proficient in course subject.

Developmental Course Fee (pc) \$100.00 **P** Applies to students in developmental course, to cover costs of academic support to students not proficient in course subject.

Online Course Fee (pc) \$100.00 **P** Applies to all students in online courses. Used to fund online courses or for face-to-face courses, this will fund the expanded use of canvas and required technology for hybrid models of instruction necessary to allow flexibility in providing courses with all modes of instruction.

Private Music Lessons (pch) \$40.00 **P** Applies to students in this course only.

## Special Service Charges

Audit (without credit)

Residents of Oklahoma (pch) \$172.00 **P** Applies to all students to cover costs of in-state tuition.

\*Non-Residents of Oklahoma (pch) Additional \$196.30 **P** Applies to out-of-state students to cover costs of out-of-state tuition. All out-of-state tuition is waived for non-residents.

ACT Residual Test Fee \$50.00 **P** Applies to students who are administered residual ACT testing, to cover costs associated with offering the testing.

CLEP Fee \$95.00 **P** Applies to students who are administered CLEP testing, to cover costs associated with offering the testing.

Departmental Examinations (where available) (pch) \$15.00 **P** Applies to students who are administered departmental testing, to cover costs associated with offering the testing.

Electronic Transcript Delivery Fee \$5.00 **P** Applies to students for transcript requests, to cover costs associated with transcript processing.

Graduation Fee \$20.00 **P** Applies to students applying for a graduation check, to cover the basic graduation cost.

## **Billing and Cost of Attendance**

Tuition and fee charges for the Fall Semester are due by September 15. Electronic notices are sent to the student's OPSU e-mail address the first week of September for the first billing statement of the Fall semester.

Tuition and fee charges for the Spring Semester are due by February 15. Electronic notices are sent to the student's OPSU e-mail address the first week of February for the first billing statement of the Spring semester.

Each subsequent month, electronic notices are sent for bursar billing statements that detail additional transactions on the bursar account. Balances should be paid by the 15th of each month. A finance charge of 1.5% will be assessed for past due charges.

Keep in mind that there are other components of your cost of attendance to consider such as housing, food, books, transportation and personal expenses. The Office of Scholarships and Financial Aid lists out each cost of attendance budget used for financial aid purposes.
