You and your parent (for dependents) will need Federal Student Aid accounts.

OPSU's school code is **003174**.

Log in to your Aggie Portal to view your award offer about a week after submission.

Basic Eligibility Criteria-Our basic eligibility requirements are that you must

- Demonstrate financial need for need-based federal student aid programs;
- Be a U.S. citizen or an eligible noncitizen;
- Have a valid Social Security number (with the exception of students from the Republic of the Marshall Islands, Federated States of Micronesia, or the Republic of Palau);
- Be enrolled or accepted for enrollment as a regular student in an eligible degree or certificate program;
- Maintain satisfactory academic progress in college or career school;
- Provide consent and approval to have your federal tax information transferred directly into your 2024–25 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA®) form, if you're applying for aid for July 1, 2024, to June 30, 2025;
- Sign the certification statement on the FAFSA form stating that you're not in default on a federal student loan, you do not owe money on a federal student grant, and you'll only use federal student aid for educational purposes; and
- Show you're qualified to obtain a college or career school education.

Your FAFSA determines eligibility for the following:

- **♣ Grants**-money that does not have to be paid back; availability based on need
- **Work-study**-money from a part-time campus job; To qualify for Federal Work-Study, you must demonstrate financial need based on your FAFSA.
- **Loans**-Money that has to be paid back; Federal subsidized loans don't accrue interest until you graduate; Federal unsubsidized loans accrue interest from the day you accept them.

Other aid that could be available:

- **Scholarships**-money received for academics or talents; Your admissions application included your application for internal academic scholarships.
