Overview

The federal government requires universities to disclose to current and prospective students if their programs of study meets licensure requirements in their state which is:

- Designed to meet the educational requirements
- For a specific license and
- Required for employment in an occupation.

Method for Disclosure

The Office of the Registrar will use reports to determine students who are prospective and current students who require disclosure.

A letter will be mailed to all students regarding the status of licensure for each respective program. Students will be directed to a single location on the university's website for the disclosure information: <https://opsu.edu/financial-aid/professional-licensure-compliance/>

Updates to the page will be made annually, or when program requirements change.
